Overview:

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) starts rolling out in July 2016. The NDIS is the most significant change in Australian Social policy since the introduction of medicare in 1975. Inclusion Melbourne is holding an information for staff and volunteers who would like to know more about the NDIS and how it works.

Objectives: The NDIS introduction will help you understand

- why the NDIS is important and how it will benefit people with a disability.
- how and when things will change for Inclusion Melbourne service users.
- what inclusion Melbourne will look like after the NDIS roll out.

Please <u>note</u> registration for all sessions start 15 minutes prior to start time.


Parking
